

## **Drug Free Pennsylvania's 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Chopper Dropper Golf Ball Drop Contest Rules:**

With the purchase of an event ticket for \$30 or an individual golf ball for \$10, each participant will be entered into the *Chopper Dropper* Golf Ball Drop event to take place on September 21, 2010, at Blue Ridge Country Club in Harrisburg. Participants will be assigned a numbered golf ball(s) based on their purchase, and may enter multiple times by purchasing additional golf balls.

On September 21, 2010, at approximately 6:10 p.m., the golf balls will be placed randomly in a bucket and dropped from a helicopter onto a custom-made hole on the first fairway at Blue Ridge Country Club. The first participant whose numbered golf ball goes into the hole will win the grand prize of \$2,500.

- 1) If multiple balls go in the hole, the ball that is at the bottom of the hole will be determined the first place winner and receive the grand prize of \$2,500. The second ball in the hole will win the 2<sup>nd</sup> prize of \$500 for being closest to the pin.
- 2) If no balls go in the hole, then no grand prize will be awarded. The ball landing closest to the hole will be determined the winner and will receive the 2<sup>nd</sup> prize of \$500 for being closest to the pin. The ball closest to the hole will be determined by measuring from the center of the hole to the ball.
- 3) The ball that lands the farthest from the hole will win the 3<sup>rd</sup> prize of \$100. The ball farthest from the hole will be determined by measuring from the center of the hole to the ball.

The purchase of an event ticket gains an individual admission to the 1-hour reception to immediately follow the drop. Winners will be announced at the reception.

### **HOW TO PLAY (Conditions and limitations):**

- 1) The event is open to participants 18 years and older as of entry date.
- 2) Odds of winning depend on number of valid entries received. If more than 500 golf balls are sold, then the odds of winning will adjust accordingly.
- 3) Deadline to enter is Monday, September 20, 2010 at 5:00 p.m. EST.
- 4) All federal, state and local laws and regulations apply.
- 5) Decisions by Drug Free Pennsylvania *Chopper Dropper* judges on all aspects of this event will be final and binding.
- 6) Winners will be notified by phone, mail or e-mail from contact information supplied. If a winner cannot be located or fails to claim prize within ten (10) days after notification, prize will be forfeited and awarded to alternate winner.
- 7) All entries become property of Drug Free Pennsylvania, and will not be returned.
- 8) By entering the contest, winner consents, without limitation or without compensation, to the use of their name, voice, photograph, and likeness for advertising and/or trade purposes, except where prohibited by law.

- 9) All applicable taxes, licenses, and fees are the responsibility of the winners.
- 10) By participating, each participant releases, discharges, indemnifies Drug Free Pennsylvania, its affiliates, board of directors, directors, employees, volunteers, sponsors, agents, and promotional partners (collectively the "releases") from any liability, loss, harm, injury, and expense whatsoever arising directly or indirectly from the use of or participation in the event.
- 11) Unforeseen events: Drug Free Pennsylvania reserves the right to change this event at its discretion at any time that Drug Free Pennsylvania becomes aware of any circumstances or occurrences which would materially affect the event's fairness. Such circumstances will be announced in a suitable way to reach the intended audience.
- 12) Winner assumes the risk of safe arrival of prize.
- 13) Employees of Drug Free Pennsylvania are not eligible to win any prizes connected to the event.

The rain date for this event is September 22, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. If the event should be cancelled for any reason, all money collected will be donated to Drug Free Pennsylvania.
